Other News of Note

The library has received an \$8,000 grant from the Maine Humanities Council for the purchase of two archival museum display cases. One case will be placed at Winslow Public Library and one at the Winslow Town Office. We will be collaborating with Fort Western on presenting displays of artifacts from archeological excavations at Fort Halifax and the three other pre-Revolutionary era forts that were built on the Kennebec River, Fort Shirley, Fort Western, and Fort Richmond. Fort Western is developing a new Center for the Study of the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Century Kennebec River and will curate the Winslow exhibits.
