January Highlights....!

Law Enforcement:

01-24-12 I investigated a Facebook comment left by a Winslow High School student on another Winslow High Student's Facebook wall. The student took a picture of a gun, alcohol bottle, baseball bat and a set of keys. The student then stated "I have a license and I can kill you." Winslow Police Department responded to the student's house and met with his parents. The student stated that the incident was a joke and a BB Gun was found in the student's room. The student was advised of how serious threats were. The student stated he was trying to look tough and was only joking with his friend. The friend was contacted and we were advised that he took the comment as a joke. On 01-25-11 the student was escorted to the principal's office upon his arrival at the Winslow High School. The student was searched for weapons and his lockers were also searched. The student was suspended for his actions. No criminal charges were pursued.

Training:

On 01-28-11 I attended Boomerang Instructor Training. Boomerang is an outreach program for first time offenders of alcohol and drug violations. This program is designed to take first time offenders of alcohol and drug violations and teach them about the risks and life choices made while using alcohol and drugs. The class is four weeks long and the participants are required to attend every meeting with a parent. The participants receive a certificate of completion at the end of the program which is then given to law enforcement which will expunge the pending criminal violation.

Community Activities:

On 01-24-2012 I presented a presentation on crime prevention to the local cub scouts. I also gave them a tour of the Winslow Police Department. Cub Scouts were shown the procedures that are followed when a person is arrested and brought to the police department. Several cub scouts participated in a finger printing station.
