Winslow Resident Arrested on Multiple Charges

A 22 year old Winslow resident was recently arrested for Criminal Trespass, Refusing to Submit to an Arrest, Violation of Probation and Escape. Officer Smedberg received the initial call that two males were removing scrap metal from a residence. SRO McGowen and Detective Henderson also assisted at the scene. After the subject was arrested on the probation violation, Officer Smedberg began adjusting the handcuffs from his front to behind his back so he could be transported. As she began cuffing him he fled. After a substantial foot chase, taking Officer Smedberg away from her cruiser and backup officers, she was able to subdue him after utilizing her TASER. The subject was cooperative throughout the remainder of the procedure. And was transported to the Kennebec County Correctional Facility.

Waterville Man Charged with Domestic Violence

A 22 year old Waterville resident with an extensive criminal history which includes an arrest for domestic violence was recently arrested again for domestic assault. According to the officer's report, the victim was lying in bed with her infant when her boyfriend entered and began watching television. She asked him to turn it off as she was attempting to get their daughter to sleep. He became enraged, picked up the television and smashed it against her head, striking her and barely missing their infant daughter. He was later arrested for the offense after fleeing to a friend's residence in Waterville
